TEMPLATE – Second P (Chapter 13 of the book)

Use this template to outline which types of plastic you are targeting to reduce your organization’s plastic footprint.
 For example: “all single-use plastic - defined as plastic useful for less than a month, including throwaway packaging & bioplastics.”

- ➔ Be sure to plot both plastic items used in your organization’s processes as well as those received with your supplier deliveries.
- ➔ The aim is to rapidly identify high impact areas for priority action as well as some quick wins to start making a difference right away.
- ➔ Cost is a key metric. Many organizations find that eliminating single-use plastic also results in more efficient processes and cost savings too.
- ➔ It’s also important to have benchmark figures so you can demonstrate progress made.
- ➔ Find creative ways to visually convey how much plastic you are currently using and communicate your plastic reductions – see Chapter 13 for examples.
- ➔ Don’t forget to also plot current business waste costs as these should plummet as the project takes effect – see end of this template.
